RESOLUTION NO. 21-22-22 Series of 2022

RESOLUTION APPROVING THE 2023 FREE PACKAGE ANNUAL HEALTH PROGRAM FOR BJMPMBAI MEMBERS

WHEREAS, as of December 6, 2022, the Association has a total membership of Twenty Three Thousand Nine Hundred Ninety Two (23,992) members of which Twenty Thousand Nine Hundred Fifty (20,950) are active uniformed and non-uniformed personnel while the rest of the members or Three Thousand Four Hundred Thirty Seven (3,437) are Retirees and Associate members;

WHEREAS, since 2020, the Association is providing Annual Medical and Diagnostic Examination to active uniformed and non-uniformed members, a mandatory requirement of the BJMP, while the retirees and Associate members are given the choice to undergo the examination or opt for reimbursement of medicine bought for maintenance;

WHEREAS, the annual medical and diagnostic examination, now renamed Free Package Annual Health Program is being done to determine the individual physical and mental fitness of jail personnel to perform their individual assigned duties and responsibilities;

WHEREAS, the Association will appropriate the maximum amount of Two Thousand Pesos (P2,000.00) free package for each member whether uniformed personnel, non-uniformed personnel, Retirees and Associate members and the program will be Regionalized with the local laboratory Service Provider chosen by the Regions;

WHEREAS, for this purpose, the Social Services Committee recommended to the Board of Trustees that the Association set-aside an estimated amount of Forty Seven Million Nine Hundred Eighty-Four Thousand Pesos (P47,984,000.00) to be taken from free and unassigned surplus of the Association as funding for 2023 Free Package Health Program intended examination of 23,992 members;

WHEREAS, the Committee further recommended that in order to have a smooth and well-organized implementation of the program, an Implementing Guidelines must be formulated incorporating therein the experiences, observations, opinions and comments of the Board of Trustees, Implementing Officials, RESJOs, previous laboratory service providers and members.


WHEREFORE, after due deliberations and on motion by Trustee Leopoldo D Morante Jr, seconded by Trustee Doris R Dorigo, the Board RESOLVED, as it hereby RESOLVES, to approve the granting of BJMPMBAI 2023 Free Package Health Program for Twenty Three Thousand Nine Hundred Ninety-Two (23,992) members and appropriating the estimated amount of Forty Seven Million Nine Hundred Eighty Four Thousand Pesos (P47,984,000.00) for the program. RESOLVED FURTHER that the maximum amount of Two Thousand Pesos (P2,000.00) will be set-aside as funding for each member that will undergo the examination including

Retirees and Associate members that may opt for laboratory examination or reimbursement of expenses paid for medicine maintenance. RESOLVED FINALLY, that an Implementing Guidelines be crafted by the Social Services Committee for a smooth and well-organized implementation of the program for approval of the Board.
