## RESOLUTION NO. 2021-13 Series of 2021

**RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 19-19-23 ENTITLED:  
"INCLUSION OF SEVERAL SICKNESSES AND DISEASES TO BE INCLUDED IN  
THE GUIDELINES/ POLICIES FOR HOSPITAL CASH BENEFIT ASSISTANCE"**

WHEREAS, during the regular virtual meeting of the Board of Directors on March 25, 2021, Director Leopoldo D Morante Jr, Chairman, Social Services Committee called the attention of the members to Board Resolution NO. 19-19-23 entitled: "Inclusion of Several Sicknesses and Diseases to be Included in the Guidelines/Policies for Hospital Cash Benefits Assistance" and said that the Resolution should be amended;

WHEREAS, in recommending to amend the resolution, Dir Morante anchored his ground on the unequal granting of benefits and explained that members that undergo dialysis and chemotherapy were given only P15,000 while those that undertake angioplasty or heart surgery were given P60,000 that should be reduced to P15,000 and the benefit for those that endured physical therapy were not even mentioned and moved for equal granting of P15,000.00 benefits to all mentioned medical procedures to avoid inquiries in the future or demands for higher payment similar to heart surgery;


WHEREAS, Dir Jose A Esmeralda III also moved that members that undergone occupational and speech therapies because of stroke and could no longer talk should also be included in the amendments agreed by Dir Mamaril who commented that members subjected to therapies like physical, occupational and speech should be considered as one group entitled to P15,000 assistance.

WHEREFORE, based on the foregoing, on motion by Director Leopoldo D Morante Jr, seconded by Director Jose A Esmeralda III, the Board RESOLVED, as it hereby RESOLVED, to amend Resolution No. 19-19-23 by reducing the amount given to angioplasty or heart surgery procedures from P60,000 to P15,000, the same amount of assistance that will be granted to members that experienced dialysis and chemotherapy. RESOLVED FURTHER to include in the amendment the granting of P15,000 members that undergone physical, occupational and speech therapies in 2019.


